Type "ES" trucks meet all the standards of Type "E" lift trucks and have additional tools so as to avoid the emission of sparks and limit the surface temperature of forklift components.

Type "ES" trucks are more specialized and are not normally accessible. Type "EE" lift trucks meet all the requirements of Type "E" and "ES" trucks and have all electric motors and spark producing electrical components fully enclosed as Type "EE" lift trucks are normally utilized wherever a hazardous situation has been recognized. Type "EX" forklifts are specifically designed for use in environments where flammable fibers or dust or vapors could be present. These types of forklifts are constructed using no spark producing parts along with different protective measures to be able to guarantee optimum safety in the risky applications they can be used for.
