

Order Picker Attachments

Order preparation operation or likewise called order picking as it is more usually known is a process utilized within warehouse operations and comprises employees known as order pickers. The order picker's job is to take and collect articles in certain quantities so as to fulfill the client's orders prior to shipment. Order picking is an easy warehousing method. The efficiency in which this particular job is accomplished could be directly linked to the productivity of a supply chain. Therefore, order picking is among the most controlled logistic processes. Order picking falls in the category of the warehouse management system.

There are several certain types of order picking. The main types include: pick to box method, wave picking method, piece picking or picker to part method, sorting systems method and zone picking method.

The pick to box method comprises the order picker just filling the boxes with things which are from their particular station. The box then moves on to other locations to until the order is complete. In this particular technique, there is no movement of the order picker personnel. In the wave picking method, the order pickers move all-around so as to gather the necessary products for some orders. The picker to part method or piece picking is similar where the order picker or pickers move to gather the stuff required but for one order only.

In the sorting systems method, there is no movement of the order picking workers. Instead, the things are delivered to him or her by means of an automated system like for example automatic storage or a conveyor system. In the zone picking method, every order picker is assigned to one particular area. They are responsible for only realizing order picking within this particular zone.
